



Designed in collaboration with nine top universities and think tanks, GLI's flagship initiative — the Global Arts MBA — brings together world-class faculty and a network of Fieldwork partners across 40+ countries. Each year, a select Executive Cohort of 60 accomplished professionals joins the program, ready to shape the future of the cultural sector.

Highlights

- Twelve-month MBA in Arts Innovation focused on social entrepreneurship, cultural management, sustainable impact, and community development.
- Builds powerful tools through live interactive seminars led by a faculty of pioneers from neuroscience to aesthetics, revenue development to operations, and cultural economics to marketing including Nobel Prize laureates, Polar Prize recipients, Grammy winners, and TED presenters.
- Tailored academic modules curated and certified by world-class universities, including Harvard, Duke, Georgetown, McGill, Stanford, NYU, and Chicago, impart skills that address realworld opportunities.

Informed by two decades on the world's greatest stages, from Carnegie Hall to Elbphilharmonie, the Carlos Miguel Prieto Conducting Fellowship provides rising conductors with the formative tools needed to access world-class career opportunities. Fellows study gesture, analyze core orchestra repertoire, and connect with world-class conductors, orchestra principals, administrators and agents for enhanced professional guidance.

The Piano Lab combines remote and in-person immersive training, one-on-one lessons, masterclasses with Gabriela Montero, residency and showcase opportunities, and more. The 12-month program is individually tailored to each Fellow's needs, balancing performative training with 360° artist development.

Fellows receive mentorship from a range of leading music creators across the field, all under the guidance of celebrated Grammy-winning composer Gabriela Ortiz. Through its curriculum of dynamic coursework and supportive resources, fellows graduate with the professional recordings, supercharged portfolio, and enhanced network needed to take the next step in a successful composing career.






